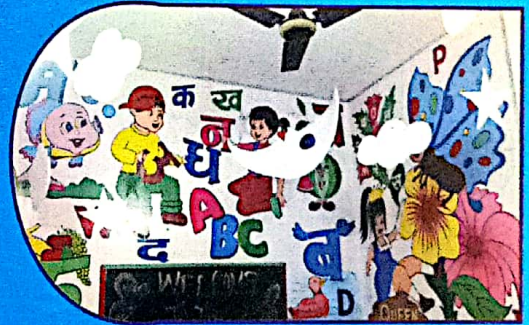
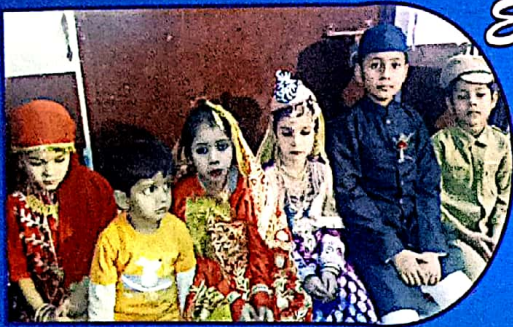

- Parents are advised to provide a mid day meal or snacks/ for their child that is healthy and nutritious, as well as drinking water (please do not sent maggie, rice, snacks like dalmoth, kurkure, p u f f s and unhealthy junk food) It is advised to the parents to make s m a l l part of meals, so that the child may form a habit of taking food by itself.
- The staff is appropriately trained to feed the younger children and ensure that the food is handled hygienically by the children Parents are requested to ensure that their children are brought a n d picked up on time to avoid inconvenience.

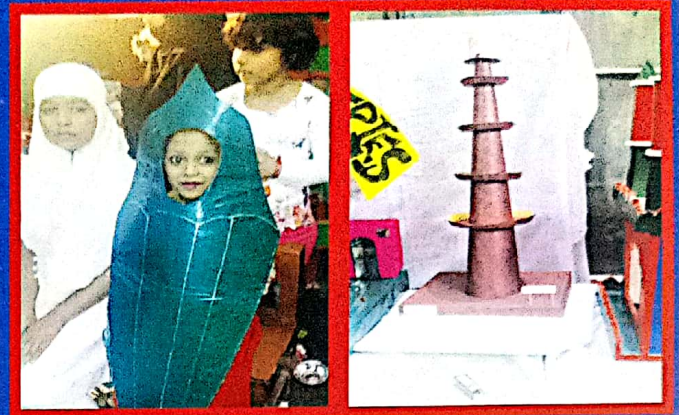
